Ambassador Daalder is a widely-published author. His most recent books include; *In the Shadow of the Oval Office: Profiles of the National Security Advisers and the Presidents They Served*. From JFK to George W. Bush (with I.M. Destler) and the award-winning *American Unbound: The Bush Revolution in Foreign Policy* (with James M. Lindsay). Other books include *Beyond Preemption: Force and Legitimacy in a Changing World* (2007); *Crescent of Crisis: US-European Strategy for the Greater Middle East* (2006); and *Winning Ugly: NATO's War to Save Kosovo* (2000). Ambassador Daalder is a frequent contributor to the opinion pages of the world's leading newspapers, and a regular commentator on international affairs on television and radio.

Before his appointment as ambassador to NATO by President Obama in 2009, Daalder was a senior fellow in foreign policy studies at the Brookings Institution, specializing in American foreign policy, European security and transatlantic relations, and national security affairs. Prior to joining Brookings in 1998, he was an associate professor at the University of Maryland's School of Public Policy and director of research at its Center for International and Security Studies.
