### **Peter Pronovost M.D.**

*Chief Clinical Transformation Officer  
 University Hospitals of Cleveland.  
 Friday, February 1, 2019*



Dr. Peter Pronovost is a world-renowned patient safety champion, critical care physician and prolific researcher. His scientific work, using checklists to reduce catheter-related bloodstream infections, has saved thousands of lives and earned him accolades, including receiving a coveted MacArthur Foundation "genius grant" in 2008. This life-saving intervention has been implemented state by state across the U.S.

Dr. Pronovost served as the John Hopkins Medicine Senior Vice President for Patient Safety and Quality and the founder and director of the Johns Hopkins Medicine

Armstrong Institute for Patient Safety and Quality. The Institute coordinates research, training and operations for patient safety and quality across JHM bringing together 18 different disciplines.

Dr. Pronovost served as the Senior Vice President for Clinical Strategy and the Chief Medical officer for United-Health. He is an advisor to the World Health Organization's World Alliance for Patient Safety and regularly addresses the U.S. Congress on patient safety issues. Dr. Pronovost is currently the Chief Clinical Transformation Officer for University Hospitals.

debuted on September 14, 2001, the week of the 9/11 attacks on the United States. Prior to becoming deputy editor, Mr. Henninger also served as the editorial page's features editor and its chief editorial writer.

Mr. Henninger was a finalist for a Pulitzer Prize in editorial writing in 1996 and 1987. In 2002, he shared the Journal's Pulitzer Prize for the paper's coverage of the terrorist

assault on September 11, 2001. His entry was an eye-witness account titled, "I Saw It All. Then I Saw Nothing." In June 2004, he won the Eric Breindel Journalism Award for his "Wonder Land" column. He also won the Scripps Howard Foundation's Walker Stone Award for editorial writing and the American Society of Newspaper Editors' Distinguished Writing Award.

A native of Cleveland, Mr. Henninger graduated from Georgetown University with a degree from the School of Foreign Service.
